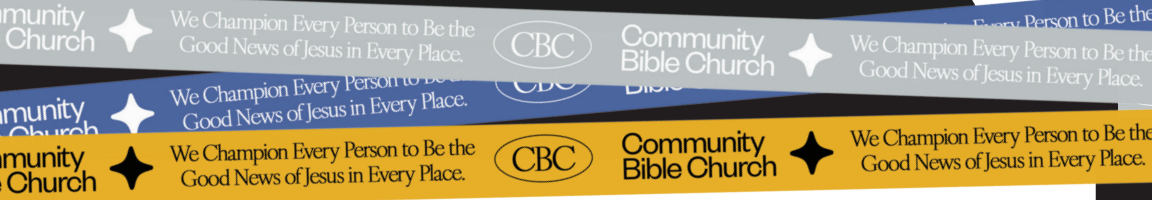

Target: You can't keep what you've got, but you can send it ahead.

I. **The _____ of _____:** *"For where your **treasure** is, there your heart will be also."* (Vs. 21)

- A. Revealed by what we Consider
- B. Revealed by what we Chase
- C. Revealed by what we Collect

II. **The _____ of _____:** *"The **eye** is the lamp of the body."* (Vs. 22a)

- A. **I Do Have Enough:** *"So, if your eye is **healthy**, your whole body will be full of light."* (Vs. 22b)
 - 1. Take Inventory
 - 2. Establish Margin
 - 3. Be Sacrificial
- B. **I Do Not Have Enough:** *"But if your eye is **bad**, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light in you is darkness, how great is the darkness."* (Vs. 23)

 - 3. Disrupts Peace

III. **The _____ of _____:** *"No one can **serve** two masters,"* (Vs. 24a)

- B. **Cancel Covetousness:** *"You cannot serve God and Money."* (Vs. 24c)

 - 2. I am not an Owner
 - 3. Think Eternally

Takeaway: Money is a tool. Greed is a trap. Generosity is testimony, for it proves who you trust and what kingdom you belong to.
