Title: Sonroof
Text: Mark 2:1-12

**Target:** Breakthrough sometimes requires you not to back down.

**I.** The <u>Word</u> preaches the <u>Word:</u> "And many were gathered together, so that there was no more room, not even at the door. And he was preaching the word to them." (Vs. 2)

**Discussion Question:** What part of God's Word has been speaking directly to you lately, but you've been avoiding or resisting it?

**Discussion Question:** When your life feels crowded, what usually pushes God's voice out of the room?

**Discussion Question:** Be honest, are you showing up just to *listen*, or are you making space for *transformation*?

- **II.** <u>Compassion</u> is fueled by <u>Conviction</u>: "And they came, bringing to him a paralytic carried by four men." (Vs. 3)
  - **A.** Jesus is the Answer: "to him" (Vs. 3)
  - **B. No Limits:** "they could not get near him because of the crowd" (Vs. 4a)
  - **C.** Counted the Cost: "they removed the roof above him" (Vs. 4b)
  - **D. Worked Together:** "they let down the bed on which the paralytic lay" (Vs. 4c)

**Discussion Question:** Who has carried you spiritually when you were too weak or tired to move forward? What did that mean to you?

**Discussion Question:** Are there people in your life right now that God is asking you to carry, even if it costs you comfort, time, or energy?

**Discussion Question:** In what area of your life are you holding back because the "crowd" (pressure, opinions, resistance) seems too thick to press through?

- **III.** <u>Faith leads to Forgiveness:</u> "And when Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, 'Son, your sins are forgiven.'" (Vs. 5)
  - A. Name Change: "Son"
  - **B. Status Change:** "Forgiven"
  - **C. Perspective Change:** "Why does this man speak like that? He is blaspheming! Who can forgive sins but God alone?" (Vs. 7)

**D. Heart Change:** "And immediately Jesus, perceiving in his spirit that they thus questioned within themselves, said to them, 'Why do you question these things in your hearts?'" (Vs. 8)

**Discussion Question:** What do you think Jesus sees in your faith today? What would He say to you?

**Discussion Question:** What's something from your past that you *say* is forgiven, but still secretly carries shame or regret?

**Discussion Question:** Are there places in your heart where you've been questioning God quietly? Can you be honest about those tonight?

- IV. A Mat becomes a Message: "I say to you, rise, pick up your bed, and go home." (Vs. 11)
  - **A.** External Validated the Internal: "But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins,"—he said to the paralytic—" (Vs. 10)
  - **B. Embrace Your Assignment:** "And he rose and immediately picked up his bed..." (Vs. 12)

**Discussion Question:** What's the "mat" you've been laying on, something that used to define you but Jesus has redeemed?

**Discussion Question:** Have you told your story lately, your real story? What's holding you back from sharing what God has done?

**Discussion Question:** If your life is a message right now, what's it preaching?

**Takeaway:** Jesus isn't asking you to carry your **Past**, He is asking you to carry your **Purpose**.

What's one bold step of faith God is asking you to take this week?
