 - A. Called to a Purpose: "rise and go"
 - B. Called to a Place: "a desert place" (Vs. 26)
 - C. Called unto Obedience: "And he rose and went." (27a)
 - for Significance: "And there was an Ethiopian, a eunuch, a court official of Candace, queen of the Ethiopians, who was in charge of all her treasure." (Vs. 27b)

- **B. HIS Substitution:** "All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all." (Is. 53:6)
- **C. HIS Salvation:** "he bore the sin of many and makes intercession for the transgressors." (Is. 53:12)

that's Simple: "for we cannot but speak of what we have seen and heard." (Acts 4:20)

- A. Prayer of Inclusion: Lord, would you allow me to be good news to someone today?
- **B. Priority of Observation:** Lord, would allow me to see who you need me to see today?
- C. Point of Connection: (Relevant, Interests, Culture, Events)
- **D. Proper Transition:** Seem, like a great person, do you mind if I ask you a spiritual question?
- E. Power of a 1st Question: What do you think it takes to go to heaven?
- F. Present Scripture: Romans Road Romans 3:10, 3:23, 6:23, 5:8, 10:9, 10:13
- G. Power of a 2nd Question: Would you like to accept Jesus as your Savior today?

Takeaway: Don't just keep Jesus personal, make him public.
