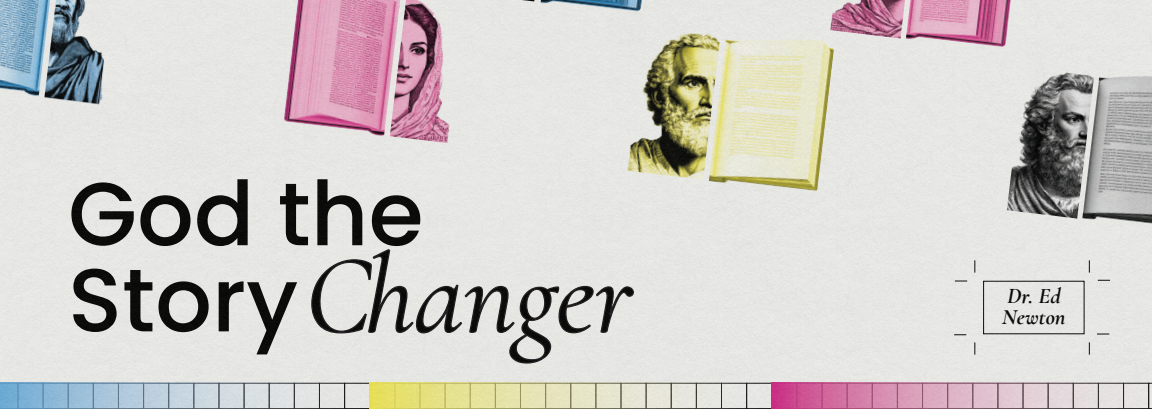

- 1. **Rahab’s _____-Stained Past:**
 - a. **Her Reputation:** “prostitute” (Vs. 1)
 - b. **Her Residence:** “her house was built into the city wall, so that she lived in the wall” (Vs. 15)
 - 2. **Rahab’s _____-Statement of Faith:**
 - a. **Full of Faith:** “I know that the Lord has given you the land” (Vs. 9)
 - b. **Full of Repentance:** “as soon as we heard it, our hearts melted” (Vs. 11)
 - 3. **Rahab’s _____-Symbol of Salvation:**
 - a. **Scarlet Cord:** “tie this scarlet cord in the window through which you let us down” (Vs. 18a)
- ***Tikvah**- belief for a better future and redemption, **HOPE**.
- b. **Set Apart:** “and you shall gather into your house your father and mother, your brothers, and all your father’s household. (Vs. 18b) *PASSOVER-Exodus 12
4. **Rahab’s _____-Story Rewritten:**
 - a. **Line of Christ:** Great Great grandmother of King David to Jesus. (Matthew 1:5)
 - b. **Hero of the Faith:** She’s named amongst the giants of the Faith. (Hebrews 11:31)
 - c. **Righteous Deeds:** Faith without works is dead. (James 2:25)

Takeaway: A rope of hope is extended to you in grace no matter your past.
