

**Title:** Kingdom Prayer (Part 3)

**Text:** “Give us this day our daily bread” (Matthew 6:11)

**Target:** The Lord’s prayer is not just to be memorized, but personalized. **\*God is Father, King, PROVIDER!**

### I. Statement of Dependency: “Give”

- A. **Our Confession:** Do not be anxious about anything, but **in everything** by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. (Philippians 4:6)
- B. **Our Comfort:** Therefore do not be anxious, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ For the Gentiles seek after all these things, and your heavenly **Father knows** that you need them all. (Matthew 6:31-32)

### II. Straight up Transparency “us” and “our”

- A. **Our Source:** The Lord is **my** shepherd; I shall not want. (Psalm 23:1)
- B. **Our Satisfaction:** Oh, fear the LORD, you his saints, for those who fear him have **no lack!** The young lions suffer want and hunger; but those who seek the LORD **lack no** good thing. (Psalm 34:9-10)

### III. Sentiment of Urgency: “this day”

- A. **Our Now:** And the LORD will guide you **continually** and **satisfy** your desire in scorched places and make your bones strong; and you shall be like a watered garden, like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. (Isaiah 58:11)
- B. **Our Need:** If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven **give good things** to those who ask him! (Matthew 7:21)

### IV. Source of Consistency: “daily”

- A. **Your Presence:** And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having **all sufficiency** in all things at **all times**, you may abound in every good work. (2 Cor. 9:8)
- B. **Your Promise:** And my God **will supply** every need of yours **according** to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:19)

### V. Staple of Sufficiency: “bread”

- A. **You’re the Manna:** I am the **living bread** that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh. (John 6:51)
- B. **You’re the Miracle:** When the righteous cry for help, the LORD hears and **delivers** them out of all their troubles. The LORD is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in

*spirit. Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the LORD **delivers** him out of them all. He keeps all his bones; not one of them is broken. (Exodus 34:17-20)*

**Takeaway: Jehovah Jireh (Provider) is not just a name, it's who He is and what He does!**
